Directions

From York : Take the A64 towards Scarborough after passing through Rillington turn right sinposted Wintringham/Luttons. At the T junction in West Lutton turn left and follow this road through East Lutton into Helperthorpe. Pear Tree Cottages are the last houses on the left before leaving village.

From Scarborough : Take the A64 towards York. At the traffic lights in Sherburn turn left. Follow sign to Weaverthorpe. At T junction turn right. Follow this road one mile to Helperthorpe. Pear Tree Cottages are the first houses on the right as you enter the village.

Has one double (with a four poster bed) and one twin bedroom.


Ground floor: Entrance hall (stable door), open plan sitting room with living flame gas fire, dining area and fully equipped kitchen with French doors to enclosed patio area.
